IMPORTANT CHANGES FOR 2017

New judging procedure/criteria. No cash prizes.

We will not be individually judging the murals this year. The only judging is whether or not the mural is based on the theme *Making Waves*. Any space based on the theme will be entered into a <u>random drawing</u> for a variety of prizes donated by our local businesses. If two spaces are painted as one mural, neither will be eligible for the drawing. Prizes will be drawn on Sunday at 4:30 at the music stage. Winners will be notified by phone or email if not present.

One space per application.

The 140 spaces available for pre-registration will be full size spaces. We will only allow one space per application and we will not honor special requests to be next to a specific person. It has become unmanageable to do so. Spaces will be assigned in order of postmark date. If two people agree to trade spaces in person at the festival, this is allowed. It is up to you to notify Registration of the change in space numbers. Prizes will be awarded to the name we have recorded to the space.

Remaining spaces sold day of festival. Cash only.

Spaces considered unique in shape, size or configuration will be available for purchase the day of the festival on a first come basis. Purchase must be in person, with \$35 in cash only. Further info will be posted on our website in early June.

Must register in person and <u>start painting</u> by Noon on Saturday or your space will be forfeited.

Your mural should be in progress and painting started by Noon on Saturday. An "X" or "be back Sunday" marked on the space is not enough. This policy is in place to avoid blank spaces on the wall. Prior arrangements may be made prior to the festival via info@artistsofthewall.com or noted on your application. LPAC will not be checking email during the festival. There will be no refunds given on forfeited spaces.

PRE-REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

Pre-Registration ends on May 26th, <u>or whenever all</u> spaces are filled.

140 spaces are available. Spaces are assigned according to postmark date. Only one space allowed per application. No handwritten special requests for location will be honored this year.

Once LPAC receives 140 applications w/all fees, preregistration is closed. **Check our website June 1**st **for a list of confirmed participants.** Any applicants who cannot be accommodated will be notified via email and the check will be returned in the mail.

There will be a selection of spaces available on a first come first serve basis on the day of the festival for \$35 (cash only).

NEW JUDGING CRITERIA

There are no cash prizes this year.

Any space based on the mural theme "Making Waves" will be entered into a drawing for a variety of prizes donated by our local businesses.

Please note: If two spaces are painted as one mural <u>neither</u> space will be eligible for the drawing.

The drawing will take place on Sunday afternoon at the music stage, and winners will be notified via email or phone if not present.

DAY-OF GUIDELINES

Sign in at the Registration tent between 9am – noon on Saturday. The tent is located north of the tennis courts at Farwell at the lake.

You will receive a designated, numbered space to paint. If you trade/change your space number, it is **your** responsibility to notify Registration. Prizes will be awarded to the person whose name we have recorded to the space.

Artists must register in person and <u>start painting</u> by noon on Saturday or the space will be forfeited.

To be considered for entry in the prize drawing, your mural must be complete by 2pm on Sunday.

REQUIREMENTS

Artists are required to provide:

- Painting tools (brushes/rollers/etc.)
- Outdoor latex or acrylic paint (available for purchase at festival)
- Tarp or sheet to protect the sidewalk and grass surrounding the mural; rags and cleaning materials to clean any mess
- Containers for washing out brushes, etc.
 Nothing, including hands, may be cleaned in the lake!
- Artists who leave a mess may be disqualified from the event—now and in the future.
